**Ramps at the sole discretion of the judge,** approved breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp: Boykin Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels & Welsh Springer Spaniels. (Boykin Spaniels may be judged on the table, ramp or on the ground.) **This list may be** revised from time to time, and the current list can be found on the AKC website in Judging Operations.

**A judge requesting** the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the day of the show. AKC approval is not required.

**Ramps may be used** in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

For dogs/bitches who have placed in a Licensed AKC Field Trial or dogs who have their AKC JH, SH or MH Title.

### **American Water Spaniels**

Shall be open to any dog/bitch who has earned a Parent Club Working Certificate or the Working Certificate Excellent or has won a ribbon in an AKC Licensed Spaniel Field Trial or Hunting Test.

### **Boykin Spaniels**

Shall be open to any dog/bitch who has earned a Parent Club Working Certificate or the Working Certificate Excellent or has won a ribbon in an AKC Licensed Spaniel Field Trial or Hunting Test.

### **Clumber Spaniels**

Shall be open to any dog/bitch who has earned a Parent Club Working Certificate or the Working Certificate Excellent or has won a ribbon in an AKC Licensed Spaniel Field Trial or Hunting Test.

### **Cocker Spaniels**

Shall be open to any dog/bitch who has earned a Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter or a leg towards a JH.

### **English Cocker Spaniels**

Shall be open to any dog/bitch who has earned a Parent Club Working Certificate or the Working Certificate Excellent or has won a ribbon in an AKC Licensed Spaniel Field Trial or Hunting Test.

### **English Springer Spaniels**

Shall be open to any English Springer Spaniel which has earned a Parent Club Working Certificate or the Working Certificate Excellent or has won a ribbon in an AKC Licensed Spaniel Field Trial or Hunting Test.

### **Field Spaniels**

For dogs/bitches, six months or older on the day of the show, who have attained the title of JH, SH or MH as well as for those that have gotten their WD or WDX Certificate.

All Regular Classes are divided by sex and are offered for all breeds or varieties of breeds unless otherwise noted below. Where classes are further divided by color, weight, or other breed characteristics, it is so indicated below and the class division MUST be indicated on the entry form.

#### Amateur-Owner-Handler Class (effective as of 1/1/2009)

Chapter 3, Section 7 - The Amateur-Owner-Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

**NR1.08100.15000. Veteran Classes** - Class for dogs and class for bitches 7 years & over. Eligible for Best of Breed/Variety. Must NOT be spayed or neutered.

**NR1.08200. Hunting Dog** - Class for dogs & class for bitches who have completed requirements for the AKC Senior Hunter or Master Hunter Title.

**00900. Best of Breed (01000. Variety) Competition**

**FOR GERMAN SHORTHAIRED POINTERS - EACH DAY**

**NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed.

**NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class** - The same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog & Produce for Get. As the judges' decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.

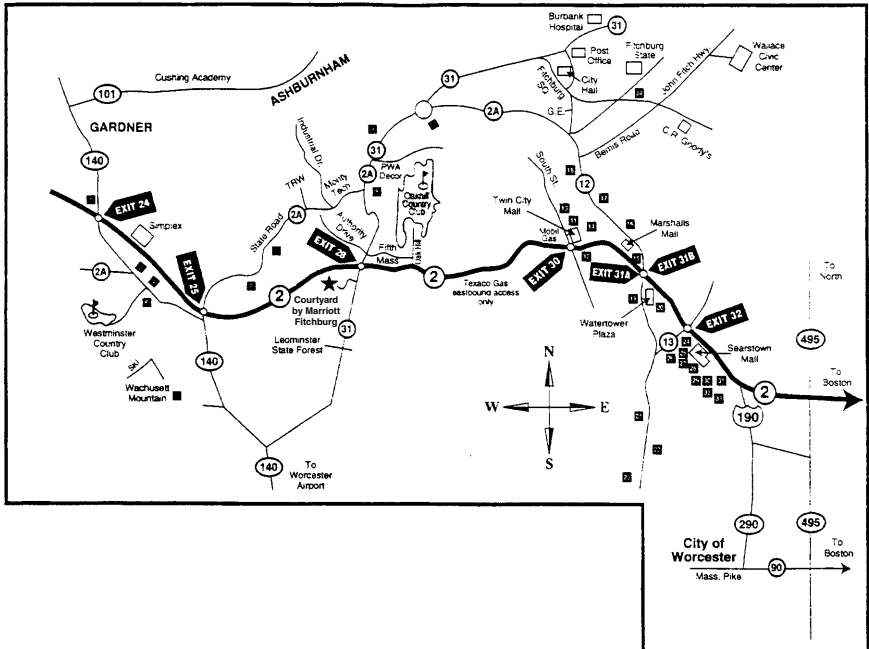

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
